
Before your child can begin the 'Ready Set Prep' program they need to be enrolled at the school.

Program Overview

Our program consists of three stages.


Stage One: Ready.....

Dates for transition will be sent home once enrolments are received. Students are invited to attend two allocated sessions of 45mins each. Please contact the office on 9702 8398 early Term 4 to book your allocated transition time. We encourage you to book your child in to attend the allocated sessions to help them get ready for school.

Stage Two: Set....

We offer 2 small group sessions where students are introduced to Prep life. They will participate in hands on Literacy and Numeracy activities similar to those done in a Prep classroom. Students will produce some pieces of work to take home to show parents what they have done during the session.

All students are encouraged to attend these sessions to begin to familiarise themselves with the school and staff as well as start to make some new friends.



Stage Three: Prep....

In the last two sessions your child will find out who is in their class for the following year. They will meet some of their classmates and all efforts are made for them to also be introduced to their teacher.

The students will participate in class Literacy, Numeracy and fine motor activities and will be introduced to the school values and routines of the classroom. They will be required to bring snack and/or lunch and a hat as they will be allowed to go outside to play in our dedicated Junior play area, an area just for Prep, Year one and two students. This is a very exciting time for students as they begin to form friendships and become familiar with the routines of school life. It is expected that all children attend these sessions. If they are unable to, please contact us.

Your child will also receive a Prep pack that is filled with goodies which will help them on their journey into Prep the following year. Please use the 'Countdown to Prep' calendar over the holiday time to help your child to familiarise themselves with independently doing daily classroom tasks and practise some counting and writing activities.
