School Wide Positive Behaviour Support - SWPBS

School Wide Positive Behaviour Support is a framework which Coral Park is using across the whole school to model, acknowledge and reward positive behaviour. Everyone in the school community is aware of our behaviour expectations and using the SWPBS framework is an effective way of reducing negative and unwanted behaviour. By focussing on good behaviour choices, students are encouraged to gain attention by doing the correct thing, rather than getting attention for doing the wrong thing.

Students are given clear details of what positive behaviour looks like and there are posters and banners throughout the school as reminders of our school values and to display them. Students choose a reward chart and gain stickers for positive behaviour and displaying school values, then when their chart is full of stickers they can select a reward of their choice.

Students are continuing to embrace our rewards system and have been displaying our school values in their everyday learning. We are seeing lots of rewards charts filling up fast and students are enjoying choosing their rewards!

Our SWPBS Captains display, model and promote our school values and assist in ensuring the framework is embraced throughout the school.

The award is presented to a Year 4 student who is regarded as a future leader in our community and displays the following qualities:

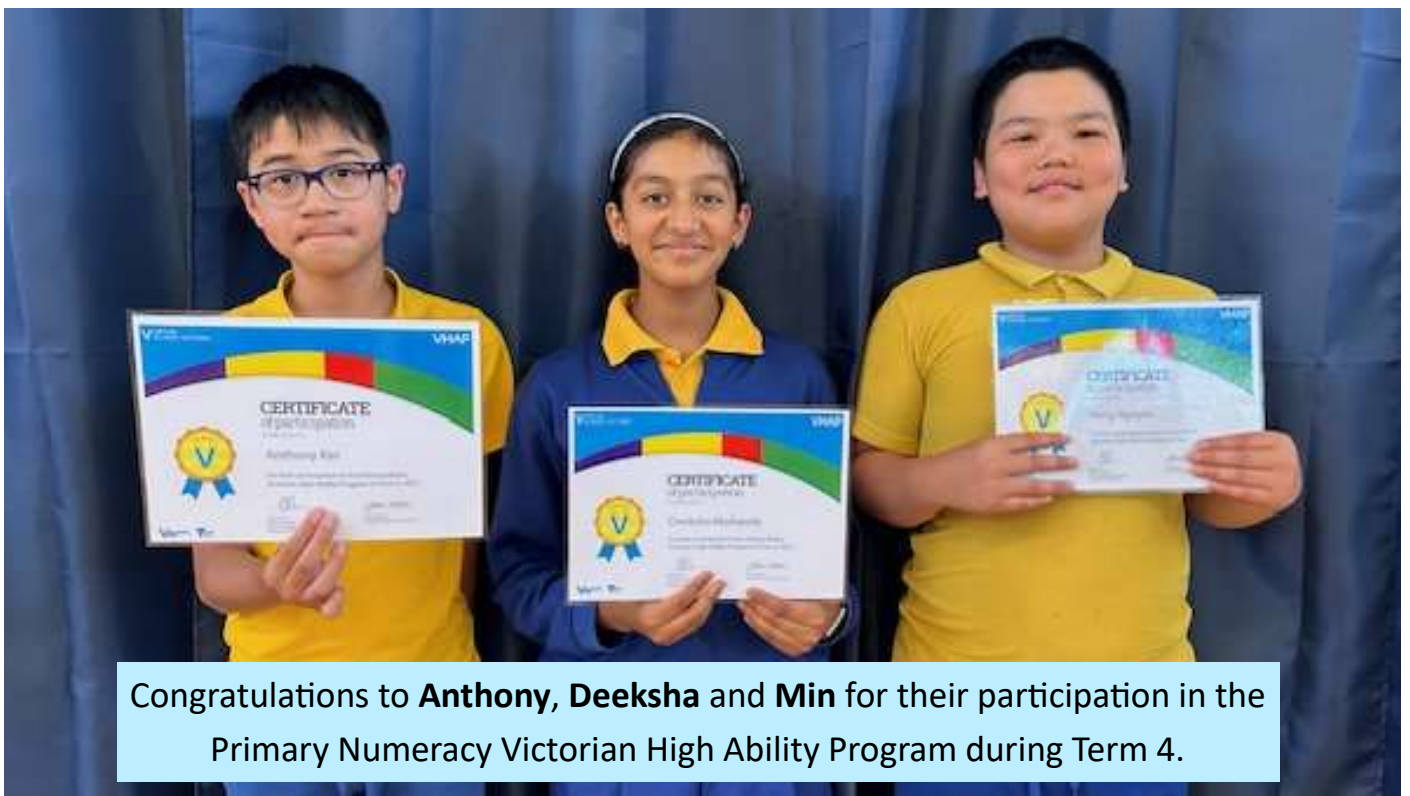
- Considerate of others

She has shown growing leadership qualities throughout her 5 years of primary school so far and she will likely become a leader in her senior years at Coral Park.

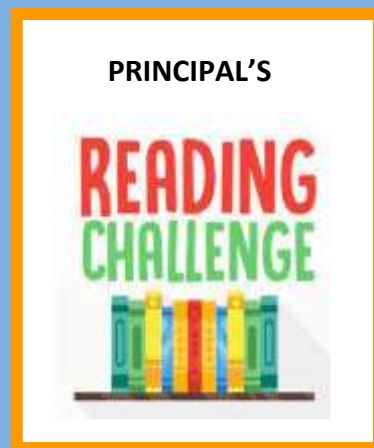
Her unwavering sense of responsibility and strong work ethic stand as a testament to her exceptional character. Azzalea is a deserving receiver of this award.
