

Monash Health Dental Services provide dental treatment under the guidelines of Dental Health Services Victoria. We provide dental care to eligible health care or pension card holders and their dependants.

Anyone experiencing an emergency problem should contact 1300 icare (1300 342 273 Option 3) where they will be placed through a triage system. Depending on the outcome of the triage options will be provided for care.

If you require general care (non emergency care) call **1300 342 273 option 3** to be placed on our waiting list.

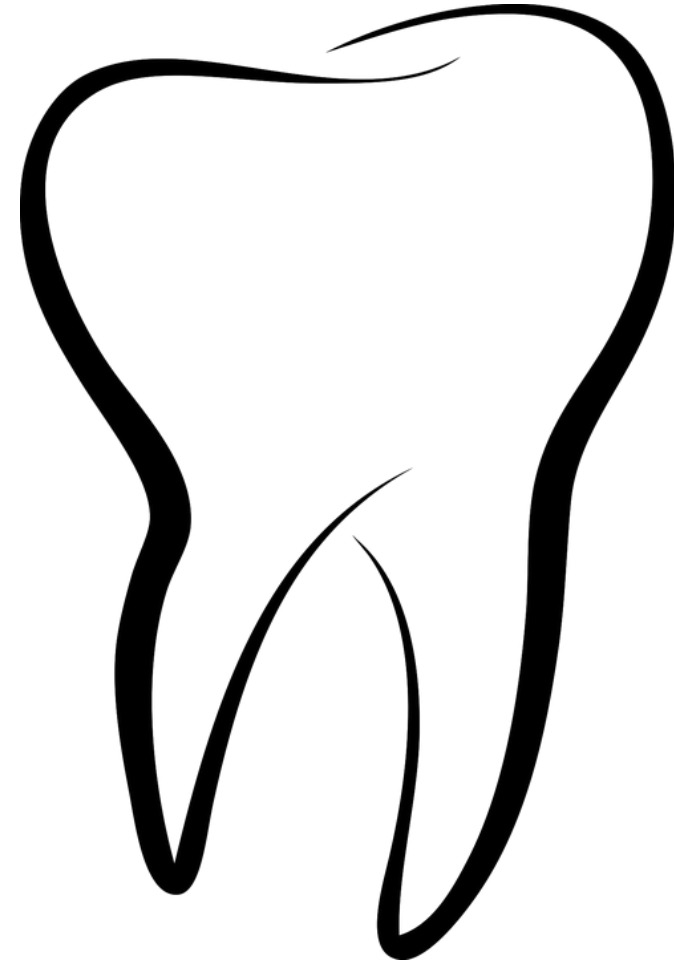

Who is eligible to use this service?

- All children aged 0 – 12 years
- Young people aged 13 – 17 years who are health care or pensioner concession card holders or dependents of concession card holders
- All children and young people up to 18 years of age, who are in out-of-home care provided by the Children Youth and Families Division of the Department of Human Services
- All youth justice clients in custodial care, up to 18 years of age
- Adults aged 18 years and over, who are health care or pensioner concession card holders or dependents of concession card holders
- Refugees and asylum seekers
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders

Dentures

Co payments for dentures are dependant on the type of dentures required. The cost is **\$70.50** per denture. **\$141** for an upper and lower acrylic denture.

Rehabilitation & Aged Care Program

Clients are referred from Monash Health Kingston Centre.

Program available Fridays at the Kingston site. Patients are co payment exempt.

Priority Access

If you fall into one of the following groups you may also be eligible for priority access to dental care; please enquire with our telephone staff.

The following groups have priority access to care:

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples
- Children (0-12 years) and young people
- Homeless people and people at risk of homelessness
- Pregnant women
- Refugees and asylum seekers
- Registered clients of mental health and disability services, supported by a letter of recommendation from their case manager or staff of special developmental schools
- Supported Residential Services Clients

If you believe you meet any of the above criteria, please inform our staff when you call to make an appointment that you may be eligible for 'priority access'.

Homeless people and people at risk of homelessness	FREE
Refugees and asylum seekers	FREE

Adults who do not fit into any of the above categories	Not eligible for general public dental care

Children 0-12 and Youth (12-17)

Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Cards holders	FREE
Children and Youth 18 years and under who are eligible for the Child Dental Benefits Schedule	FREE
Refugees or asylum seekers	FREE
Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander peoples	FREE
Children (12 years and under) not eligible for the Child Dental Benefits Schedule and who do not fit into any of the above categories	\$34.50 per child for a course of general care
